World War II Monument Restoration



This original monument was built in 1946 by the Onarga Lions Club to honor the 315 servicemen and women from Onarga who served in World War II. Our goal is to restore the monument with similar brick, and mounting a black granite slab with the engraved names of the 315 persons who served.

Our Memorial Goal: To raise \$ 15,000. This will cover the renovation, lighting and landscaping.

How to Contribute: A donation of \$100 or more will gain you a 4" x 6" engraved granite brick, which will be laid in two slabs on the ground in front of the monument.

Program Details: There will be a total of 120 memorial bricks. The bricks will be engraved to display your chosen company, group or individual names.



All donations of \$100 or more received by Jan. 15, 2012 will include a memorial brick.

Any bricks ordered after Jan. 15th will cost \$130, so order now.
